

Jeanne Adam, the author of the *world-famous *fantasy stories, was born in a small town in France in 1961. When she was a child, she liked to make stories. She often told those stories to her mother.

When she wrote the stories, her *childhood experiences *influenced her. For example, the main character's black shoes are *similar to the shoes that Jeanne wore. Also, her stories *are set in a *mansion with a dark forest. She often saw similar places near her home.

Later, she worked as an English teacher. However, she never gave up her dream to be a *professional writer. She wrote some stories, but she *was not satisfied with them.

One day in 1988, she took a bus to *Paris. On the bus, she came up with a great idea. It was a fantasy story for children. In the story, many strange things happen to a young boy. He actually has *magic powers, but he has not realized it vet!

Without a pen and paper, she created the story all in her head. A lot of characters were born. Her *imagination never stopped. On the bus to Paris, she planned the whole story. It was eight *volumes long.

Six years later, she finished writing the first volume. Her next *task was to find a *publisher. Many publishers, however, thought that her book had a problem. An 80,000-word book might be too long for children.

She hoped to find a publisher quickly, but it took her two years. She chose the pen name J. F. Adam. She used her own *initial J and her favorite grandfather's initial F.

The first book *was published in 1995. Both children and adults around the world loved it. Her dream came true.

Now, *although many people love her stories, some do not like the work. They do not want children to believe in magic. However, she says that the magic in her work is a kind of *metaphor. It is actually a *hidden power that everyone has. Her stories *encourage children to find their own hidden power.
